The procedure is relatively simple but results in the vast majority of patients getting better. Although not yet approved by the FDA for PTS, Dr. Lynch has successfully treated patients in 48 states around the nation and in nine different countries.

"It's extremely rewarding to help relieve others of their pain from PTS," Dr. Lynch said. "I hope I can ease some of the suffering for those who feel lost."
